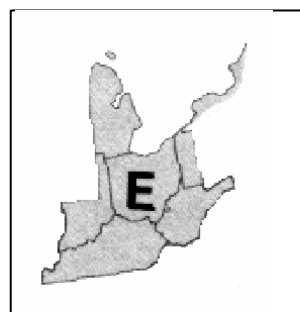


Notice of Race

O'Day Area E Singlehanded Championship

Wolf Lake Yacht Club,
May 17, 2008



Rules: These races shall be conducted under the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008 as modified by the Prescriptions of US SAILING, the current Championship Conditions, The International Sunfish Class Rules (ISCA), the Notice of Race (NOR) including any amendments to the NOR except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions.

Alteration of Class Rules: ISCA rules are altered so that membership in the Class is not required; the first sentence of ISCA rule 4.1.1 is deleted; and a compass may be taped to the deck.

Advertising: The event is classified as a Category C event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code).

Boats: The event will be sailed in Sunfish Class boats (bring your own).

Eligibility: All competitors MUST BE:

- A. At least age 16 years in the Calendar year.
- B. **Must be current members of US SAILING.**
- C. A member of one of the following:
 - 1) A Sailing Club or Sailing Organization (SC/SO) or Sunfish Class Association, belonging to a Sailing Organization (SA) recognized by US SAILING;
 - 2) A Sailing Club or Sailing Organization, or Sunfish Class Association, belonging directly to US SAILING;
 - 3) A Community Sailing Program (CSP) which is a member of the local SA;
 4. A member of or a drilling Reservist of the Military Service.
- D. Each Competitor's SA/SO, CSP shall be located within the geographical borders of Area E.
- E. No competitor after entering this elimination may enter any other elimination for the finals for this year, after participating in this elimination.

Entry Fee: \$15 entry fee includes coffee, donuts and lunch (Extra lunches available for \$5).

Registration: Pre-registration by May 3, 2008 is encouraged; however, on-site registration will be available. Registration must be on the Official entry application forms that can be downloaded from the US SAILING website

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be distributed at the Skippers Meeting.

Scoring: The Low point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the racing rules as modified by in the Sailing Instructions and/or the Conditions will apply.

Decisions of the Jury: Decisions of the Jury will be not be subject to appeal as this is elimination event.

Life Jackets: All competitors in US SAILING Championships, at all levels, shall wear, while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing a U.S. Coast Guard (or Canadian) approved PFD, except when ORC regulations apply.

Note: It is expected that the highest placed eligible finisher will compete in the US SAILING National Singlehanded Championship to be held at the Sayville Y.C. , Blue Point, NY August 6-10, 2008.
